TOUR DESCRIPTION

USS MIDWAY & FLYING LEATHERNECK MUSEUM TOUR

Thursday, May 19

No other carrier has the history or the crew to match the USS Midway. Its 47-year career spanned from the end of WWII to Desert Storm in which more than 225,000 Americans served aboard. "Midway Magic" is now a premier attraction in downtown San Diego that opened in 2004. Its self-guided audio tour allows you to explore the 60 exhibits and 24 restored aircraft at your own leisure. Then it is onto Seaport Village for lunch on your own, where you will find 50-plus one-of-a-kind shops, 17 unique eateries and outdoor entertainment. After lunch you'll head to the Flying Leatherneck Museum, the only museum in the World dedicated to preserving the incredible contributions made by Marine Corps Aviators and their ground support personnel. There is an outdoor area housing over 20 aircraft and indoor displays of memorabilia and artifacts dating to the earliest days of Marine Corps Aviation.
